Case studies



Interdisciplinary care teams to manage chronic patients

Context: Need to find appropriate solutions to ensure the transition from an health care system based on acute management to one based on chronicity.

Case: analysis of (multiple) solutions adopted by Italian regions to deliver integrated social and health care for chronic patients

Expected Results: To show characteristics of at least three different models applied by Italian Regions that can potentially show variability in resource use and outcomes (eg. access to emergency rooms; reduction in admission in hospital; increase in home care services and patients satisfaction)

Tumor Board Review

Context: foster collaboration and cooperation among professionals with complementary skills and competences that work together to share latest evidences ensuring the best treatment through a personalized pathway for cancer patients.

Case: the definition of an optimal model for tumor board review is needed. A review of the state of the art of multidisciplinary coordination beyond regional cancer networks and PDTAs in clinical centers

Expected Results: Tumor Board review to be considered as a the medical service guaranteed to all citizens (LEA)
